At the Business Breakfast on Sunday morning of Alumni Weekend, Fletcher Academy asked the you for help with seven areas of need on the campus: new tables and chairs for the art room; five laptops and one LCD projector for various classrooms; a covered bike rack; a portable scoreboard for intramural games; various musical selections for band and choir; equipment for the drama team; and a special injector for the willow tree.
